With many Irish festivals reporting a decrease in entries, numbers are on the increase at Inniscarra due to the superb quality and consistent fishing that venue has to offer, arguably the best in Ireland.

Anglers travelled from many parts of the UK, Ireland & Europe and it was the Dutch anglers who were the first to master the consistent winning 4m whip method with bags of Roach & Hybrids of up to 26kg, which saw them return to Holland with a large slice of the prize money.

Vintners Cup Winner Trevor Platt



Mancunian angler Trevor Platt became only the second angler to win the Vintners cup twice.

Day 1 - Peg 38 Graveyard section - 17,900kg of roach and hybrids using red maggots alternating between a 5m whip & long pole short line at 8m feeding a ball of groundbait laced with caster every cast.

Day 2 - Peg 12 Rooves Bay section - 27,500kg of hybrids using red maggots fished on a 5m whip.

Day 3 - Peg 30 Garden Centre section - 14,400kg roach and hybrids using the tactics as day 2 above.

Celtic Shield Winner Arie Roubos



Dutch angler Arie Roubos became the 2013 Celtic Challenge Shield winner on his first ever visit to Inniscarra and he certainly showed many of the regular anglers how to fish the venue with biggest 3 day festival weight of the week 69,950kg.

Day 1 - Peg 5 The Wall section - 20,850kg of Roach on 4.5m to 5.0m line to hand pole, maggots and casters used as hookbaits feeding a ball of groundbait and casters every cast.

Day 2 - Peg 19 Rooves Bay section - 23,000 Kg mixed bag of roach and skimmers using same tactics as above.

Day 3 - Peg 35 Graveyard - 26,100 Kg mixed bag of roach, skimmers and some hybrids on 4.5m line to hand pole using red maggots as hookbait.
